Stained Glass and Ornate paneled windows from Calvary Reformed Church (later Common Ground Church). The building was built in 1915 and flourished under fourth pastor Rev. Martin R. De Haan. Rev. De Haan was deposed from the Reformed Church following his refusal to perform infant baptism. He formed Calvary Udenominational which gathered in the Kent Theatre on Monroe NW, and later became the imposing Megachurch on the East Beltline we all know and love.

CDKII ventures now owns the property (including the home on the opposite corner) and proposed a renovation to create a two level restaurant and seven one and two bedroom apartments. Nothing came of the proposal, and the building and property now sits in disrepair.

I decided to photograph this abandoned church in my neighborhood in response to news that the ICCF has raised almost \$13 Million to build 200 units of affordable housing on unused church property by 2030. YIGBY!
